Your child qualifies for a new program at Summit in the 2023-2024 school year. We are adding a special intervention program next year that goes above and beyond the academic intervention teachers are providing in the classroom. Our new CULTIVATE program will provide two levels of support for students: those below the 25th percentile on the i-Ready Diagnostic, and those with a diagnosed learning disability. Your child may qualify for one or both programs listed below, pending their admissions screening.

## CULTIVATE, Full Program: For Students with Learning Disabilities (Including ADD/ADHD)

For those <u>with</u> diagnosed learning disabilities, one-on-one sessions with a special education teacher will help address specific learning needs and goals. For the full program, your child must have a diagnosis of a learning disability such as dyslexia, ADD/ADHD, ASD, OHI, language processing disorder, etc.

Participants in this program will receive up to 2 individualized sessions each week, plus classwork and assessment modifications and other classroom support. A special education teacher will meet with the student's parents to develop a service plan, and reports will be given throughout the year detailing the student's progress towards reaching his/her goals. These students will also spend at least two periods of WIN (What I Need Time) per week meeting with the special education teacher in a small group. Cost is \$1200/year.

## CULTIVATE, Partial Program: For Students without a Diagnosed Learning Disability, but Needing Intense Intervention

Students in the partial program will receive 1 individual or small group session with our special education teacher per week. No modifications to classroom, homework, or assessments will be made, but this program may be a way to identify if further evaluation would benefit the child (i.e. there is an undiagnosed learning disability). *Please note, we cannot diagnose a learning disability, but we may be able to provide the parent with important information that can be used to arrange for appropriate assessments. Summit does not provide this assessment; it is the parent's responsibility financially and practically.* Reports will be given throughout the year detailing the student's progress towards reaching his/her goals. Participants will also spend at least two periods of WIN (What I Need Time) per week meeting with the special education teacher in a small group. Cost is \$1000/year.

## CULTIVATE, WIN Only: For Students Below the 25th Percentile

Students without a known learning disability that perform below the 25th percentile may meet with the special education teacher during at least two periods of WIN (What I Need Time) per week in a small group. The teacher will work with students to address learning gaps and help them improve in reading and mathematics through targeted and specific interventions without requiring the child to miss regular classes or instructional time. Cost of this program is \$850/year.

Congratulations! Based on his/her final i-Ready or MAP test, your child qualifies for our new special enrichment program next year for students needing additional challenge and enrichment. Our new SOAR (Students with Outstanding Academic Results) program will provide students performing at or above the 90th percentile in reading and/or mathematics with the opportunity to collaborate with other high-performing students and explore topics directly tied to the students' interests.

The program will meet at least three days per 5-day week during WIN (What I Need) Time. Participants will not miss regular instruction. Students may spend time learning about LEGO Robotics, a specific time or event in history, reading and discussing a challenging piece of literature, creating a new invention, or whatever the students' imagination and interest leads the group to discover!

The SOAR program will be offered for a fee of \$1,500 for the year, or \$150/month from July - April (to cover services provided August - May).
